## TRADEcho Next Functional Release and Legacy Customer Development Service Update

---

The purpose of this Service Announcement is to inform customers that on **Friday 27 April 2018**, the TRADEcho Customer Development Service (CDS) will be updated with Release 10 B. The documentation has been updated on the London Stock Exchange website to reflect this. Updated documentation can be found under the 'TRADEcho – Next Functional Release' section at the link below:

As a result of the upgrade, the TRADEcho CDS environment will be in maintenance mode on **27 April 2018** and may become unavailable for customers.

Future updates regarding release 10 for both CDS and Production, will be announced in due course.

### Legacy CDS

Additionally, we would like to inform customers of the introduction of a Legacy CDS environment for TRADEcho.

From **27 April 2018**, the existing '20 November Market Structure' TRADEcho CDS environment will be used as the TRADEcho Legacy CDS' environment. This will allow customers to test against the current production version of software. Please note that Legacy CDS should not be used for testing future releases and functionality or to perform conformance testing for future releases. The TRADEcho Connectivity guide has been updated to reflect these changes. Details can be found under the 'TRADEcho – Technical Specifications' section on the above URL.
